The children have enjoyed our final week for this half term. They have been doing lots of fun activities focused on our book 'Sharing a Shell' as well as our Maths topic-time.

Our new topic is 'Ready, Steady, Grow': - in this project your child will take part in practical activities to explore where food comes from. They will learn what seeds and plants need to grow as well as growing a variety of plants. They will explore what constitutes a healthy lifestyle, including eating fruit and vegetables, exercise and teeth brushing. They will find out about life on a farm and about baby animals.

How you can support your child at home:

- Visit your local library and find books about farms to share.
- Make a shopping list together and go to the shops to buy the food.
- Grow some quick growing plants or make a cress head.
- Talk about healthy foods.

Maths- In Maths we will be learning all about finding, building and representing numbers 9 and 10. This will allow the children to develop a deeper understanding of both numbers and the various ways in which they can be made.

How to support your child at home:

Can we please ask that you work in partnership with us to help your child reach their full potential by reading with them, signing the record and ensuring it is in school every day.
