Maths- In maths we will be exploring and investigating 3D Shapes and revisiting 2D Shapes.

How to support your child at home:

- Have a 3D shape hunt at home
- Draw a picture using shapes
- Continue to listen to the doubles song
- Continue to listen to the number bonds song
