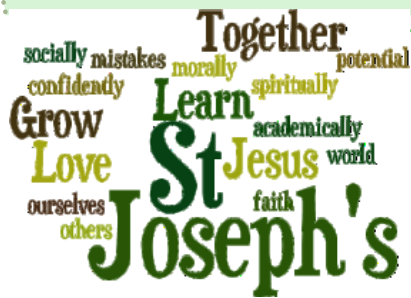

Read Write Inc

IN the final week of school the children will continue to have daily phonics sessions in their year groups which will focus on sound knowledge, letter formation and spelling.

If you have RWInc books at home that should have been sent in during the year please can you send these back to school next week as we will be carrying out an audit of our resources and ensuring that we have the appropriate materials ready to make a prompt start in September.

Over the course of the next few weeks Mrs Barugh will be carrying out final assessments for all the children so that they are appropriately grouped for September.

The Year 1 phonics screening results will be issued alongside the end of year report and Year 2 pupils who re-took the test will also have their results issued at this time.

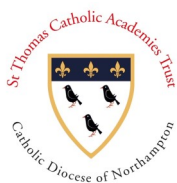
