

Headteacher Message

One of the key themes of this Jubilee year is FREEDOM, a gift we are fortunate to enjoy. During this week's assembly, we reflected on how blessed we are to have the freedom to live our lives as we choose. However, with such freedom comes great responsibility, requiring us to reflect on the choices we make. Pope Francis has called us to embrace this responsibility during the Year of Hope.

While we may not be physically restrained, we can still find ourselves trapped—becoming slaves to material distractions such as video games or social media. These distractions can pull us away from helping others and living out our values. Together, we acknowledged that this is a challenge many of us face.

We drew inspiration from Jesus, who experienced distraction and temptation during His time in the desert. Yet, He stood firm, resisting those temptations to follow the path of righteousness. We are called to follow in His footsteps.

This Lent, I encourage your child to set aside a distraction in their life—something that may pull their focus away—and instead prioritise the values that truly enrich their spirit, by putting God at the centre of their journey.
