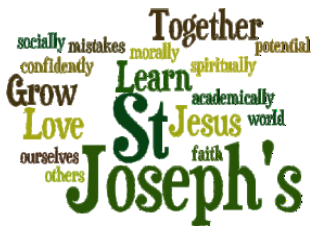

They attended an award ceremony at the weekend and were presented with book vouchers and a certificate by Sarah Green, our local MP.

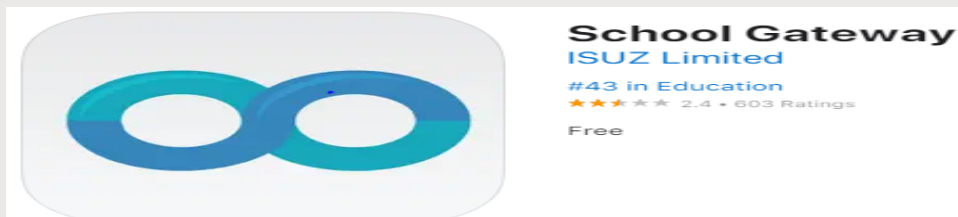
