

Both classes were acting out the story. Year 2 were rehearsing in the hall so we did not visit them. Year 3, 4 and 5 were all learning about different maths topics. They were very quiet and focused on their learning. We also went to the library with some of the Year 1 children to help

them chose books at the correct Accelerated Reader level.

Read Write Inc

- The final RWInc group sessions of the year took place today. The final scheme books have been sent home (for this year) and are due back in school on Tuesday 9th July.
- For the next two weeks the children will continue to have daily phonics sessions in their year groups which will focus on sound knowledge, letter formation and spelling.
- If you have RWInc books at home that should have been sent in during the year please can you send these back to school next week as we will be carrying out an audit of our resources and ensuring that we have the appropriate materials ready to make a prompt start in September.
- Over the course of the next few weeks Mrs Barugh will be carrying out final assessments for all the children so that they are appropriately grouped for September.
- The Year 1 phonics screening results will be issued alongside the end of year report and Year 2 pupils who re-took the test will also have their results issued at this time.

As we have said on many occasions reading is the absolute key to academic success and we firmly believe that children need to keep up rather than catch up! To this end we would recommend that over the summer it would be really beneficial to keep up some practice with phonics. 


Reception Trip—Hertfordshire Zoo

Following feedback regarding the calendar view on the School App, we have adjusted the capability to view events.


