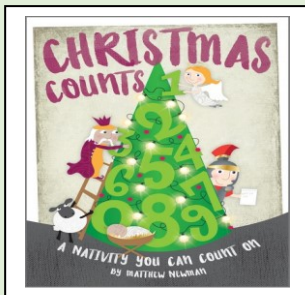

Information for Preschool Parents

- ❖ All children are included in the Nativity.

Information for Reception Parents


- ❖ All children are included in the Nativity.

Information for KS1 Parents

- ❖ All children are included in the Nativity.
- ❖ Children will come to school in uniform as normal and change into their costumes at school.
- ❖ After the Nativity, children will return to class to follow the normal routines of the day.

Costume Requirements

Child from Poland	Black/red full skirt/trousers, white top, waistcoat, colourful ribbons
Child from China	Plain pyjamas and Chinese hat, or simple kimono type wrap
Child from Australia	Beachwear, with sun hat (or Santa hat)
Child from Malawi	Bright coloured fabric shirt or tunic
Child from USA	Party clothes
Child from Ireland	Irish dancing clothes or clothes in Irish flag colours (green/white/gold).
