You always strive to challenge yourself in lessons and take part in many activities outside of school to develop your knowledge.

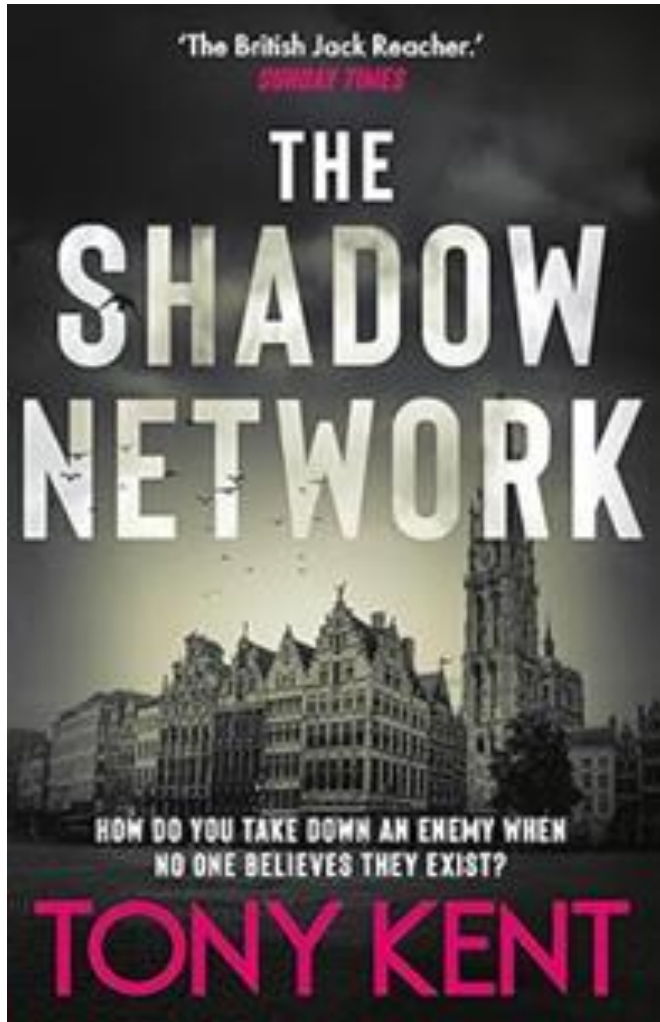
